You only need a name for your project to get started. Create a no-frills folder structure by executing:

```
stupipy new -p mysweetproject
```

A folder structure will be created with all the files required to distribute your project to pypi. If you have additional needs, stupipy supports the following options:

- -font_name, -f Specifies the font for the ASCII art generated for files. See pyfiglet's documentation for available fonts.
- -sphinx, -no-sphinx Choice to include sphinx documentation folder/structure. **Default is -sphinx**.
- *–locale, no-locale* Choice to include localization folder. **Default is –no-locale**.
- -licensename, -l Type of license file to generate. Available options are:
 - MIT
 - BSD
 - Apache
 - ISC
 - WTFPL

Default is MIT.
